All DeLand, Daytona Beach and New Smyrna Beach, Florida, Areas are included within their respective city limits. General District Urban Area includes Holly Hill and South Daytona.

City populations are taken from the U. S. Census for 1960.

The Wildlife Management Area boundary as shown on this map is approximate and subject to change by the Florida Game and Fresh Water Fish Commission.

In congested road areas local roads are indicated by a single line only. For details refer to inset maps of this county.

Portions of railroads are omitted in order to show topography.
